Special Instructions :

- i) All the Principals/Heads of the institutions should communicate the list of students admitted in their colleges/Institutions to the university within 15 days from the last date of admission as notified by the university.
- ii) Students admitted after the last date as specified above shall not be considered for enrolment in the University and therefore, shall not be permitted to appear at the University examinations.
- iii) All Govt. and other holidays are calculated on the basis of last year statistics. It is likely to be same except small variations after the declaration by the Govt./Authorities. The schedule of such holidays are separately notified by the University at the beginning of the Calendar year
- iv) Theory and practice examinations will also be held on Sunday and public holidays.
- v) M-Card (Machine Card) must be sent by the Principal/University Heads of the Department, within 30 days from the last day of admission as notified by University
- vi) Machine cards (M-Cards) of all examination must be sent by the Principal/University heads of the Department on or before 16th August'2009 for Winter'2009 Semester Examination Positively.
