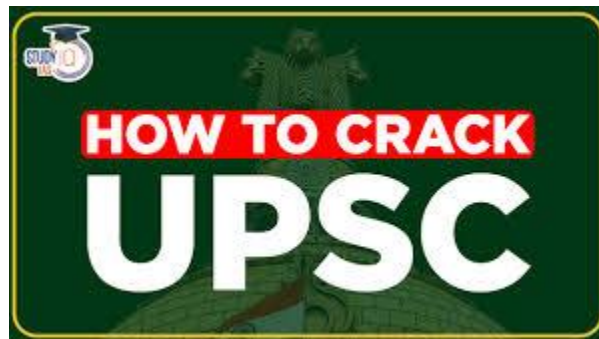

Seminar Report

Objective- The objective of the seminar was to create awareness among students about the career opportunities available through the Maharashtra Public Service Commission (MPSC) and Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) examinations. Mr. Tajnekar provided valuable insights into the examination pattern, eligibility criteria, syllabus, effective preparation strategies, time management techniques, and the importance of consistency and dedication in achieving success in competitive examinations.

During the interactive session, students actively participated by asking questions related to exam preparation, study resources, career planning, and balancing academic studies with competitive exam preparation. The speaker motivated the students by sharing practical tips, success strategies, and real-life experiences, inspiring them to pursue careers in civil services.

Description- The Department of Information Technology at KDK College of Engineering, Nagpur successfully organized a seminar titled “Seminar on Carrier Guidance for how to crack MPSC-UPSC Exam”, featuring expert speakers Mr. Rahul Tajnekar from Rahuls Academy, Nagpur. The event aimed to educate undergraduates about strategic career options, particularly within MPSC & UPSC exams, while highlighting the intrinsic advantages and growth paths associated with government careers.

Mr. Rahul Tajnekar provided a detailed overview of both the Maharashtra Public Service Commission (MPSC) and Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) examinations. He explained the eligibility criteria, age limits, examination stages, and selection procedures for various administrative services. Students were introduced to the Preliminary Examination, Main Examination, and Personality Test (Interview), along with the marking scheme and qualifying criteria for each stage. This information helped students gain clarity about the structure and requirements of these prestigious competitive examinations.

A major focus of the seminar was on effective preparation strategies. The speaker highlighted the importance of understanding the examination syllabus thoroughly before beginning preparation. He advised students to prepare a realistic study plan with daily, weekly, and monthly targets. According to him, consistency and

disciplined study habits are more important than studying for long hours without proper planning. He encouraged students to build strong conceptual knowledge rather than relying solely on memorization.

The speaker discussed the significance of standard reference books, NCERT textbooks, government publications, newspapers, and authentic online resources in competitive examination preparation. He stressed that reading newspapers regularly is essential for improving awareness of national and international events, government policies, economic developments, science and technology, and environmental issues. Students were also encouraged to refer to magazines and reports related to current affairs to strengthen their general awareness.

Time management was another important topic covered during the seminar. Mr. Tajnekar explained that balancing academic studies with competitive examination preparation is possible through proper planning and consistent effort. He advised students to divide their study time effectively among different subjects and allocate sufficient time for revision, mock tests, and practice sessions. He also suggested maintaining short notes for quick revision before examinations.

The seminar emphasized the importance of answer-writing practice for the Mains examination. The speaker explained that good knowledge alone is not sufficient unless it is presented effectively within the prescribed time limit. Students were guided on structuring answers with clear introductions, logical explanations, suitable examples, and concise conclusions. He also recommended solving previous years' question papers and attempting regular mock tests to improve writing speed, accuracy, and confidence.

Mr. Tajnekar motivated students to develop analytical thinking, problem-solving skills, communication abilities, and decision-making qualities. He explained that these skills not only help in clearing competitive examinations but also contribute to overall personality development. He encouraged students to remain positive, confident, and focused throughout their preparation journey, despite challenges and setbacks.

The seminar also highlighted the role of technology in competitive examination preparation. Students were introduced to various online learning platforms, digital study materials, educational applications, and government websites that provide authentic information and study resources. The speaker advised students to use digital tools wisely while avoiding unnecessary distractions on social media.

Throughout the session, the speaker shared inspiring stories of successful civil servants who achieved their goals through determination, hard work, and perseverance. These examples motivated students to believe in their own abilities and work consistently towards achieving their career aspirations. He emphasized that success in competitive examinations is a result of dedication, continuous learning, and a positive attitude rather than intelligence alone.

The seminar created a highly interactive and engaging learning environment. Students appreciated the practical guidance, motivational insights, and systematic approach shared by the resource person. The session not only enhanced their understanding of the MPSC and UPSC examination process but also inspired them to explore career opportunities in public administration and government services.

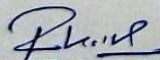

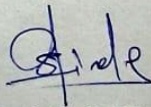

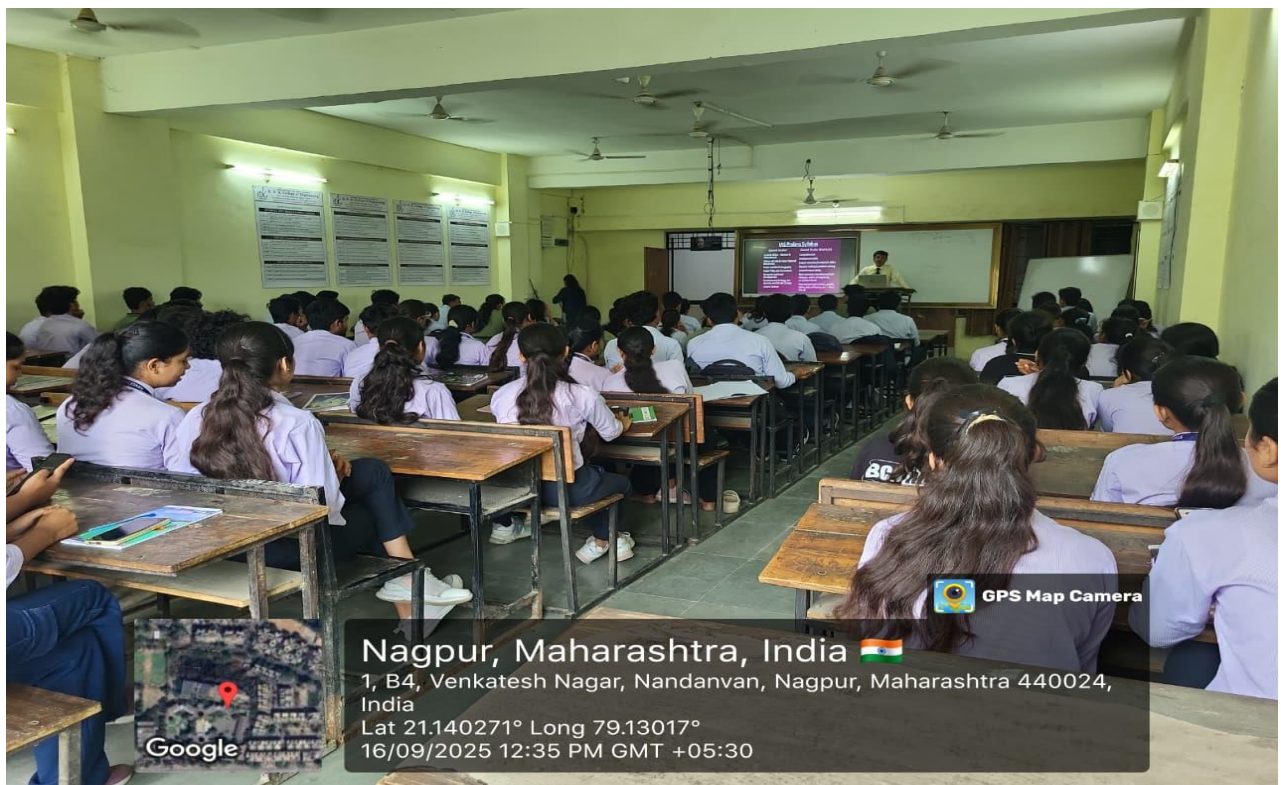
