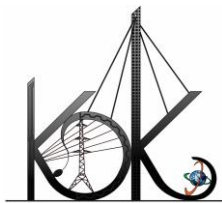
Objective

Green Campus/Plastic free campus Policy

Policy Content

- The ambience of the college should be very suitable for conduction of academic and non-academic activities.
- Several trees should be planted in the campus.
- Foliage plant should be planted for decorative purpose.
- The plant having Ayurvedic medicinal value should also be planted in the campus.
- The Neem trees, Pipal (Ficus religiosa) trees and Vad (Banayan) trees should be preferred for plantation because of their medicinal value.
- The mango trees which provide oxygen should also be planted in the campus.
- Nobody should be allowed to pluck the flowers.
- The leaves of the trees fallen on the ground should be used for preparation of manure.
- There should be adequate supply of water to the plants and trees.
- Neither the students nor the employees should be allowed to trample the green grass in the campus.
- The students and employees who come to the college should be required to park their vehicles at earmarked parking places.
- Nobody should be allowed to move their vehicles on the green grass in the campus.
- There should be friendly path ways for pedestrians.
- It should be guarded that there is no movement of vehicles in the campus.
- It should be ensured that the animals do not enter the campus.
- There should be total ban on use of plastic in the college campus.
- The ambience of the college should be beautiful and landscaping with trees and plants should enhance the beauty of the campus.
- It should be ensured that not a single drop of rain water is wasted and is utilized to water the plants and trees.
- The rain water should be used to reinforce wells and ponds.
