Chairperson Principal Dr. Valsson P. Varghese introduced the new members of IQAC and welcomed them in this first IQAC meeting of session 2025-26. He directed the Member Secretary, Dr. Nina R. Dhamge, to begin conducting the meeting's agenda.

Item 1: To confirm the minutes of previous meeting held on 05/04/2025

Resolution 1: Member secretary, Dr. N. R. Dhamge read the minutes of the last meeting held on 05/04/2025. She asked whether any member had any modification or correction to suggest in the minutes of the meeting. No member suggested any modification or correction, therefore the minutes of the last meeting were confirmed.

Item 2: Action taken report

Resolution 2: Member secretary, Dr. N. R. Dhamge presented the Action Taken Report of the last meeting and after a brief discussion, the ATR of 05/04/2025 was approved by the members.

Item 3: Status of preparedness for Peer Team visit for NBA accreditation of IT department

Resolution 3: Dr. V. P. Varghese informed the members that IT department is expecting a NBA Peer Team Visit in September 2025 for dept. accreditation. He asked Dr. S. P. Khandait, HoD (IT) to complete the documentation by the end of July 2025 and also submit the plan of action for the visit including the mock visit by experts from VNIT.

Item 4: Course absorption scheme

Resolution 4: Discussion was held on implementation of course absorption scheme for autonomy. It was resolved in the meeting that an equivalence committee comprised of principal, vice-principal, dean (aca.) and all BoS chairmen shall function to evaluate the course absorption schemes and eligibility of students seeking admission in 2nd, 3rd and 4th year of KDKCE (Autonomous).

Item No. 5: Induction Program of First Sem. B. Tech. 2025 & Direct second year students.

Resolution 5: In this respect Dr. A. M. Badar, Vice-Principal brought to the notice of the meeting that, Induction program should aim to ease the transition for newly admitted students into college life, familiarizing them with the institution, its resources, and the academic and social environment. The induction program shall include the sessions on Yoga, Universal Human Values, Code of Conduct etc. Dr. G. H. Agrawal, In-charge First year shall propose a detail plan of Induction Program for the students of First Year B. Tech. as per the AICTE guidelines to be held in the month of August/Sept. 2025; subject to the Admission process of first year B.Tech. It was also resolved that duration of Induction Program for the direct second year admitted students shall be of one day. Similarly Induction program for MCA and MBA programs shall be proposed by Computer Application department and Business administration department. IQAC accepted the proposal.

Item 6: Review of results of all programmes for S-2025

Resolution 6: Review of results of RTMNU B.Tech. results of Summer 2025 examination was taken. Concerned HODs are advised to take necessary steps to maintain the results of all semesters. Dr. S. S. Ambekar, CoE, KDKCE had put forward the results of Autonomous UG and PG programmes. Dr. A. M. Badar, Vice-Principal, congratulated for timely declaration of result of I

& II Semester Autonomous Examinations. He also suggested that Dean Academic shall review and analyze the results for further processing/ action. The report shall be submitted to Principal, KDKCE within 15 days of the declaration of the last result (S-2025).

Item 7: Preparation of academic calendar of autonomous and University affiliated programmes for the session 2025-26

Resolution 7: Dr. N. R. Dhamge informed the house that Academic calendar with reference to Academic Calendar of RTMNU for V & VII Sem. B. Tech. has been already published and classes of V & VII Sem. B. Tech. are underway. Dr. N. R. Dhamge, Dean (Academics) had presented the draft academic calendar of autonomous programmes and these calendars were approved by IQAC.

Item 8: Review of various ERP modules for autonomous UG and PG.

Resolution 8: Prof. D. B. Awachat alongwith Prof. H. V. Gorewar and Mr. A. B. Bute are advised to incorporate the required modules for smooth functioning and updating in various ERP modules for the higher semesters of autonomous UG and PG. IQAC approved the proposal.

Item 9: Efforts of Research & Development

Resolution 9: Dr. V. P. Varghese, Principal, KDKCE suggested that each department shall submit at least two research proposals for research grants by RTMNU, UGC etc. IQAC approved the proposal. Proposals for Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) events shall also be prepared by the Heads of all departments.

Item10: Review of campus placement activities

Resolution 10: IQAC reviewed the report submitted by Dr. D. M. Holey, T & P Coordinator. The report included campus placement activities undertaken by Training and Placement cell for the session 2024-25. IQAC members suggested to enhance the placement drives in the session 2025-26.

Item 11: Review of Internships

Resolution 11: IQAC reviewed the report of Internship activities undertaken by all the departments as well as T & P department for the session 2024-25. IQAC members suggested that internships shall be promoted amongst all the students of II and IV semesters also.

Item 12: Review of Skill Development activities/ courses

Resolution 12: IQAC members discussed the Skill Development activities and courses taken up by all the departments. The report for 2024-25 is to be submitted by Dr. G. H. Agrawal and Dr. A. Jaiswal.

Item 13: Review on industry collaborations.

Resolution 13: Review of industry collaborated activities conducted by different Department is taken. It is decided to strengthen the activities further. All the HODs are advised to take necessary measures to enhance internships of students, Industrial visits/ tours etc. Review of new MoUs signed with different institutions/Industries is taken.

Item 14: Formation of Students clubs.

Resolution 14: All departments shall form the Students clubs like Coding club, Sports Club, Voter club etc to foster a range of crucial skills and values, including technical proficiency. Each department shall form these clubs.

Item 15: Plan of upcoming curricular and co-curricular activities/SDPs/Workshops etc.

Resolution 15: The review of last years conducted activities like Conferences, FDPs/ STTPs, Workshops, Guest/Expert lectures, Seminars/webinars, awareness programs, celebration of different important days like Independence Day, Republic Day, Constitution Day, and Engineer's Day etc. is taken. HODs of each Department shall submit the plan of upcoming curricular and co-curricular activities/SDPs/Workshops for the year 2025-26. IQAC accepted the proposal.

Item 16: Feedback Analysis of the session 2024-25 from all stakeholders and action taken.

Resolution 16: Each Departments obtained the feedback from Students, Teachers, Parents, Alumni and Employers for Even Semester of Session 2024-25. Feedback on Curriculum was also taken from all the stakeholders. Feedback Analysis and the action taken based on the feedback is to be submitted by respective HODs to the IQAC. Prof R. Khule, Asst. Professor ETC will coordinate the same.

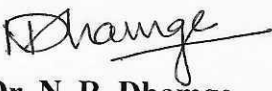
Item 17: Plan for the conduction of International Conferences, FDP/STTP, workshops or any other activity

Action Taken Report for IQAC meeting held on 05/07/2025

1. Mock visit for NBA accreditation of IT department was done on 6 Sept. 2025. Peer team visit is postponed till further notice. The documentation process for the NBA Peer Team Visit is underway. The Institutional documents are being prepared under the Guidance of Dr. S. P. Khandait.
2. Course absorption scheme is implemented for autonomous programmes as per the University norms. These schemes outline the process for students to be absorbed into the new system. Course absorption schemes strive to provide fair treatment by mapping old subjects to their new equivalents. The scheme of course changes as per the university policies, syllabus, or the implementation of a new academic system like the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS).
3. One week Induction program was scheduled for the Students of First Sem. B. Tech. & Direct second year students by the first year In-Charge Dr. G. H. Agrawal. Bridge courses and Induction Program was started on 28th Aug. 2025. Prof D. S. Satone was the Induction program In-Charge.

Bridge courses of Mathematics and English were offered to the newly admitted students.

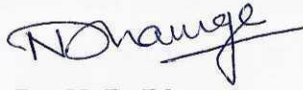
Item 9: Review of participation of students and staff members in MOOCS and NPTEL courses.

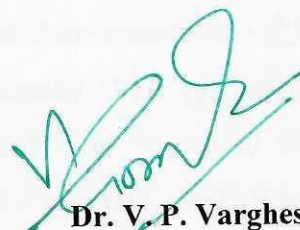
Item 13: Any other matter with the permission of the Chair

As the quorum of the meeting was full Chairman, Dr. Valsson P. Varghese, called the meeting to order. He directed the Member Secretary Dr. Nina R. Dhamge to initiate the meeting's agenda. Member secretary, Dr. N.R. Dhamge desired a very warm welcome to all the committee members in the fourth and last meeting of IQAC of the session 2025-26.

Item 1: To confirm the minutes of the last meeting held on 22 January 2026.

Resolution 1: Dr. N.R. Dhamge read the minutes of the last meeting held on 22/01/2026. As no members present in the meeting have suggested any modification in the minutes of the meeting, the minutes of the last meeting was unanimously passed.

Item 2: To confirm the Action Taken Report of the last meeting.

Resolution 2: Member secretary, Dr. N. R. Dhamge presented the Action Taken Report of the last meeting and after a brief discussion, the ATR of 22/01/2026 was approved by the committee members.

Item 3: To review the preparedness of conduction of SPARK-2026 to be organized by Civil Engineering Department.

Resolution 3: Dr. S. R. Satone, Head of Civil Engineering Department, informed in the meeting that SPARK-2026, the 22nd National Symposium of K.D.K. College of Engineering will be organized by the Department of Civil Engineering on 27th April 2026 in association with Indian Concrete Institute (ICI), Indian Society for Technical Education (ISTE) and Institution of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering (IETE). The conference will be held in Hybrid mode. Dr. Swapnil Satone further stated that Research paper presentation, Poster competition and Project Competitions will be the main features of SPARK-2026.

Item 4: To review the report of NBA Expert Team Visit for IT Department.

Resolution 4: In this regard, Dr. S. P. Khandait, Head, Department of Information Technology, gave complete account of three day visit of NBA Expert Team for IT Department. She was directed to submit the detailed report of NBA Expert Team visit to the IQAC highlighting the areas in which the challenges were faced during the expert visit.

Item 5: To review the report of International Conference jointly organized by CSE and AI&DS Departments.

Resolution 5: Dr. A.A. Jaiswal, Head of CSE department and convener of International Conference, put on the table the report of International Conference on “Emerging Trends and Research in Computer & Electronics Exigencies-2026”. The International Conference was jointly organized by CSE and AI&DS departments on 24th January 2026. The review of the report of International Conference was taken by all the Committee members. Dr. S. M. Malode, Head of AI&DS department furnished information about the details of keynote speakers, session chairs, research papers received from India and abroad, number of research papers presented by research scholars, students and faculty members.

Item 6: To review the preparedness of the institute for NBA Accreditation of five UG programs viz. Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering and Computer science & Engineering.

Resolution 6: Vice Principal, Dr. A. M. Badar instructed the concerned Heads of Departments to prepare NBA pre-qualifier considering Current Assessment Year (CAY) as 2025-26. These departments should calculate their Student Faculty Ratio (SFR) and shall update all necessary documentation at the earliest. Mock audits will be conducted to assess the preparedness for NBA Accreditation of these five UG programs. Likewise, Dr. A. M. Badar advised to schedule presentations on NBA pre-qualifier by the faculties from concerned departments. Further he suggested to made necessary improvements in laboratories and infrastructure of the institute. It was resolved to implement the proposed action plan for the preparedness of the institute for NBA Accreditation of these five programs.

Item 7: To review the FDP/ SDP/ Workshops for faculty, students and supporting staff

Resolution 7: The committee members reviewed the FDPs, SDPs and Workshops conducted during the session 2025-26. In this regard, Vice Principal, Dr. A. M. Badar advised that the SDPs organized for students should be particularly subjected to skill enhancement outcomes and placement relevance. Dr. V. Varghese also suggested to conduct more training programs and workshops focusing on increasing technical skills and soft skills. It was resolved in the meeting that all departments must organize at least one Faculty Development Program in a semester. Further he instructed all Heads of the Department to submit the ATAL FDP proposals for the next academic session 2026-27. It was resolved in the meeting that the Institute shall submit five regular Faculty Development Programme (FDP) proposals and one proposal for an advanced ATAL FDP.

Item 8: To review the Training & Placement drives for Alumni, third year and final year students.

Resolution 8: Dr. N. R. Dhamge presented the report of placement drives organized by T&P department in the session 2025-26. Vice Principal, Dr. A. M. Badar informed the meeting that the College is planning to appoint a Training Agency named as “Gryphon Academy” to provide guidance to the students for proficiency in aptitude, GD and interview skills during the placement drives for the students of AI&DS, IT and CSE branches. There was a two day orientation workshop organized by Gryphon Academy for the third year students of AI&DS, IT and CSE programs. Principal, Dr. V. P. Varghese appreciated Training & Placement officer for the successful conduction of two day orientation workshop which will turn into a full-fledged 100 hours training program for the students of AI&DS, IT and CSE programs after the End Semester Examination of the Even semester.

Item 9: To review the Research grant Proposals.

Resolution 9: Member Secretary, Dr. N. R. Dhamge brought to the notice of the meeting that two Research proposals from the college have been granted by RTM Nagpur University. Departments of Artificial Intelligence & Data Science, Computer science & Engineering and Department of Computer Application have submitted the Research project proposal in session 2025-26. Department of Master of Business Administration is advised to expedite the process of submitting the research proposals for sanctioning. Appropriate seed money for the Research proposals can be sanctioned. The information given by Dr. N. R. Dhamge was noted by the members present in the meeting.

Item 10: To review the activities under Green Audit, Gender Equality, Environment Awareness, human values etc.

Resolution 10: The review of various activities under Green Audit, Gender equality, Environment awareness and Human values was taken by all the committee members. Department of Master of Business Administration organized a program titled “MARDANI-2K26” under Gender Equality on the occasion of Women’s Day. This was followed by a self-defense workshop conducted for the students. Department of Civil Engineering organized Guest Lectures on “Role of smart Infrastructure in sustainable cities” and “Civil Engineering Rebooted: Skill, Sites & smart cities” with reference of Environmental awareness. Also activities like Tree plantation, Swachhata Abhiyan, Poster-making competition on environmental themes were organized by NSS and other departments of the college. Likewise Guest lectures and seminar on environmental awareness was also organized focusing on topics like environmental conservation, cleanliness, tree plantation drive, etc. Activities under human values like meditation and Yoga sessions were conducted by the department of Basic Science & Humanities.

Item 11: To review the conduction of Value-added course, NPTEL courses etc.

Resolution 11: Dr. N. R. Dhamge, Dean Academic, informed to the members that Value added courses were organized for students to enhance skills and knowledge beyond the core curriculum, focusing on employability. Each department offered value added certificate courses for the students of both Even and Odd semesters during the session 2025-26. Dr. S. P. Khandait, SPOC In-charge, KDKCE, reported on the enrollment and successful completion of NPTEL courses by faculties and students during the July–December of session 2025–26. Further she stated that the examination of NPTEL courses for the session January–April 2026 is scheduled in the month of April/ May, so the result for these NPTEL courses is awaited. The meeting resolved that faculties and students who have excellent performance in NPTEL courses are to be acknowledged with gratitude and examination fees shall be refunded by the College.

Item 12: To review the various activities conducted by Departmental Student Forums/ Clubs/ Sports department, etc.

Resolution 12: Member secretary, Dr. N. R. Dhamge, informed the members that the performance of Departmental student association bodies is based on the various activities conducted by the forum. These activities are evaluated through a competition at institute level named as Best Student Forum Award. The Best student forum is awarded during the annual cultural event Navonmesh-2026. PICSEL, a forum of Computer Science and Engineering Department was awarded as the Best Student Forum for 2024-25. As per the report received from the Sports department; activities are regularly organized by the Sports department of the College on every Saturday and Sunday to promote physical fitness and overall well-being among students. These activities include a variety of indoor and outdoor sports such as Chess competition, Table-Tennis, Arm-wrestling, Tug-of-war, Mix-cricket, volleyball, Kho-Kho, badminton and athletics. The students excelling in State/ National level sports events are to be acknowledged by the College. It was resolved in the meeting that all departments shall mandatorily conduct ICT-based activities, Language and Communication based activities and Sports related activities for the students.

Item 13: To review Industry related Internships and Projects.

Resolution 13: In this regard, Dr. S. R. Satone, Head of Civil Engineering Department, put on the table the list of UG and PG Projects done by the students which are undertaken in association with industries. The committee members emphasized on the final year project's relevance to real-world industrial applications. Further he presented updates on student participation in internships across various organizations. It was resolved in the meeting that all departments should increase internship opportunities for students.

Item 14: To review conduction of Internal Course Audit for theory and practical courses.

Resolution 14: Dr. V. P. Varghese, Principal, enquired Dr. N. R. Dhamge regarding the status of Internal Course Audit for theory and practical courses of ODD semester 2025-26. Dr. N. R. Dhamge presented the report on the conduction of internal audits of all departments. Dr. V. P. Varghese advised Dr. N. R. Dhamge to verify the accuracy of data, confirmation of proper documentation of remedial actions and incorporate necessary improvements while receiving the audit reports of all departments. Student publications, journals and research papers published in International Conferences, SPARK (National Conference) from all departments were reviewed. 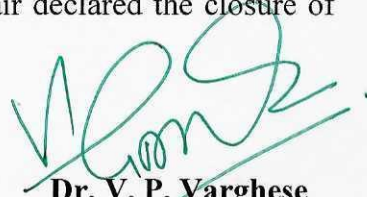
Item 20: Any other matter with the permission of the Chair

Institutional Audit Framework and Methodology Academic and Administrative Audits is an evaluation process used by Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) to assess and enhance the quality of academic processes. It involves a detailed examination of various aspects, including teaching methods, curriculum effectiveness, student support services, and faculty performance. Regular academic audits enable HEIs to identify areas for improvement and implement changes to enhance the overall quality of education. This process contributes to the continuous improvement of academic standards, helping institutions achieve their educational objectives. The Annual Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) at KDK College of Engineering is the primary strategic instrument for institutional quality enhancement. As an autonomous institute, the AAA serves to align departmental performance with the rigorous mandates of AICTE, UGC, and autonomous status. This process is not a mere recording of data; it is a critical diagnostic tool designed to evaluate academic rigor, identify systemic performance gaps, and ensure the institution remains at the vanguard of technical education through continuous improvement. The Annual and Administrative Academic Audit evaluated departments' adherence to quality standards, ensuring academic severity and excellence. It also assessed the capacity of departments to innovate and adopt best practices in their disciplines. This proactive approach demonstrates the Institute's commitment to staying at the forefront of educational advancements, fostering an environment that encourages innovation and excellence. The evaluation utilizes a standardized multi-parameter scoring rubric. For institutional benchmarking, results are normalized across a 425-point scale. The scoring scale and subsequent descriptor interpretations are as follows:	

Purpose of Annual Academic and Administrative Audit

- To evaluate academic processes, governance, and outcomes across departments and programs, ensuring alignment with institutional goals, regulatory standards, and continuous improvement.
- To understand the existing system and assess the strengths and weaknesses of the departments.
- To suggest the methods for improvement and for overcoming the weaknesses.
- To identify the opportunities for academic reforms.
- To suggest the methods for continuous improvement of quality as per the criteria and reports by NAAC, NBA and other bodies.

Process of the audit

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of KDK College of Engineering has conducted the internal academic audit as one of the activities of IQAC. There were 29 internal auditors and 10 external auditors for the conduct of various department audit. The auditors were selected from various departments based on their experience. 10% of the faculty from each department were selected as auditors. For the audit analysis, total 4 parts and 37 criteria were identified for evaluating the department performance for which rubrics were also given. Total marks allotted for department audit was 425. For analysis of audit, 37 criteria were restructured into 17 criteria. Comparison was made between 9 departments by the IQAC team based on the report submitted by the auditors.

Scoring Scale and Descriptor Interpretation

To maintain audit rigor, the 425-point scale used in departmental evaluations.

Academic Audit Instrument

The Audit Instrument contains scoring guidelines aligned with Ranking and accreditation parameters, providing a concise overview of departmental data and documentation. This base document is a guide for awarding scores to departments based on four criteria.

A. Curriculum and Infrastructure: 50 marks

B. Faculty information: 100 marks

C. Student information: 115

D. Teaching-Learning innovations: 160 marks

The audit instrument evaluates performance across four essential criteria (A-D), distilled into four core pillars for this report: Curriculum and Infrastructure, Faculty Research Competence, Student Outcomes, and Teaching-Learning Innovation. Certain metrics are exempted for departments where the metric's relevance or applicability is limited due to the department's current operational status or the nature of its Programmes. This facilitates a holistic assessment of whether a department is merely functioning or truly excelling.

Comparative Departmental Performance

The 2024-25 audit cycle reveals substantial performance variance across the nine audited departments. Audit findings indicate a widening gap between high-performing technical units and professional programs requiring immediate administrative oversight.

The following is an analysis report of the **Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA)** for the **2024-2025** session at KDK College of Engineering, conducted by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). The audit evaluated nine departments based on a maximum score of **425 marks**.

- **Recommended Benchmarks (Part A):**

Most departments scored high on interdisciplinary courses and adequacy of area. However, additional important facilities varied; for example, Civil Engineering developed an **Interactive Smart Board (ICT)** and a **Centre of Excellence** in this sub-category.

- **Faculty Information (Part B):**

- **Research & Consultancy:** Ongoing research projects are a significant.

- **Student Information (Part C):**

- **Results & Progression:** Most departments achieved high marks for results, Student progression to higher studies or employment.
- **Professional Development:** Internship scores were generally high across engineering branches, with **AIDS, Civil, CSE, ETC, Electrical, and IT**.

- **Teaching-Learning Process (Part D):**

This area showed the highest levels of consistency. Nearly all departments received full marks for maintaining academic calendars, satisfactory teaching loads, and implementing continuous improvement plans.

Inferences from the Audit

- Audit data confirms the **Department of Civil Engineering** as the institutional leader, with other departments following the path.
- **Core Engineering Strength:** Civil, CSE, and IT show robust academic and administrative processes, particularly in teaching-learning and student documentation.
- **Progressive Research Culture:** While publications are present, the funded research projects across most departments are in progress.
- **Consultancy Potential:** All departments have a significant consultancy revenue stream for industry services.
- **Infrastructure:** The development of infrastructure is consistent across the institution.

Institutional Recommendations for Quality Enhancement

The 2024-25 audit highlights "excellence". All the departments are consistently fulfilling the targets. These high-performing areas serve as examples of best practice and provide valuable lessons that replicate mostly to improve performance across the entire organization.

- **The "Civil Model" for Consultancy:** All technical departments must adopt the Civil Engineering model for consultancy. A mandatory target of two patent filings and consultancy income is recommended for all HODs.
- **Digital Content Acceleration:** IQAC will mandate that each faculty member produce at least two high-quality digital learning modules per semester. This initiative will surely enhance the availability of digital learning resources, improve student engagement and support blended and online learning environments, while nurturing a culture of innovation in teaching and learning.
- **Entrepreneurship Standardization:** Every department must establish an "Entrepreneurship/ Incubation Cell" activity tracker, following the Mechanical Engineering model.
- **Research Grant:** All departments should apply and get at least one research grant per year from agencies like AICTE or DST etc.
- **Industry-Institute Interaction (III):** All departments should strengthen their industry ties to increase industrial visits and industry-based projects.
- **Faculty Incentives:** Faculty awards at the **International and National** levels should increase by implementing an incentive scheme for national/ international recognitions.
- **Digital Innovation:** While teaching activities are strong, departments should be encouraged to develop specialized e-content and innovative pedagogical tools.

KDK College of Engineering remains dedicated to its vision of **"Transforming Society through excellence in Education, Innovation and Research."** However, achieving this requires an uncompromising Commitment to quality standards and the immediate rectification of the deficiencies identified in this audit.
