(03-06-2021)

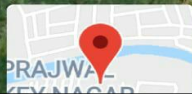

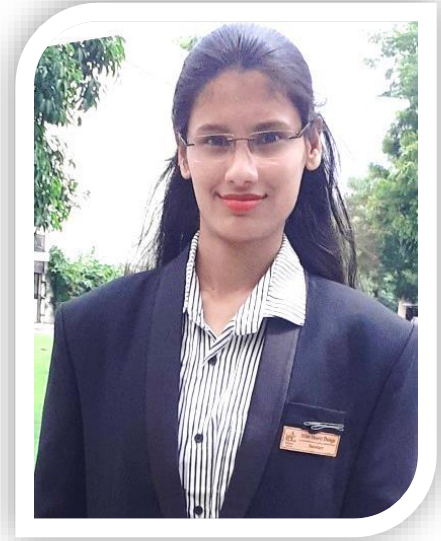
